Strengths

1. The Conventional chalk& Board teaching process is augmented by employing modern teaching aids.
2. In most of the department the average experience of faculty is above 15 years. Every teacher previews the syllabus of the allotted course, prepares lesson planning and executes the same.
3. The creative ideas and hidden talents of the students are revealed by conducting open house project exhibitions and rewarding the best projects.
4. Frequently, seminars, workshops and symposia on state-of-the-art subjects are conducted by inviting the experts from industries and academic institutions.
5. Industrial visits, training and industry-based projects are carried out by a good number of students.
6. Faculty members and students are encouraged to work on industrial projects to help the industries in solving their problems.
7. It is Proposed to start a R&D and consultancy cell to cater to the needs of aspiring industries and generate revenue.

Weakness

No major weaknesses are noticeable with regard to the various aspects. However, it is always felt that the geographical dislocation of the institution in respect of presence of major industries, the overall performance in various institutional activities is affected.
